We are seeking friendly, hardworking individuals to join our hospitality team. There may be opportunity for cross-training with the server position, enabling you to acquire new skills and experiences in a dynamic environment.

Flexible scheduling is available, with varying schedules based on the assigned department. 6-8 hour shifts in Mornings (starting at 6:00am) and/or Evenings, Monday – Friday. Occasional Weekends and holidays in support of special events. Looking for applicants with year-round availability.

JOB SUMMARY

The Barista (FSW – Food Service Worker) positions are located within the U. S. Naval Academy's Non-Appropriated Fund Instrumentality (NAFI), Naval Academy Business Services Division (NABSD) 1845 Coffee locations, and other satellite locations, Annapolis, Maryland. NAFI is an entity that generates its own funds through its operations, and is not funded by Congress.

The Barista position provides the knowledge, skills, and adaptability, necessary to multitask effectively in diverse restaurant, catering, and cafe environments.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Welcome every guest, offer menu recommendations, and ensure every customer leaves satisfied with their experience. Maintain speed and accuracy during peak hours to ensure minimal wait times.
- Provide friendly, fast service while accurately entering orders and processing payments via the POS system.
- Prepare high-quality espresso drinks, teas, and specialty beverages following house recipes and quality standards.
- Handle, warm up, and serve pastries and light food items according to food safety protocols.
- Keep the service areas, and guest seating clean, organized, and sanitized throughout the shift.
- Clean and maintain espresso machines, grinders, and brewers to ensure longevity and flavor quality.
- Monitor inventory levels and restock milk, beans, and paper goods as needed
- Other duties may include:
 - Prepares coffee and tea beverages, sandwiches, fruit and vegetable salads, and box lunches.
 - Assists with preparation and execution of catering events, sets up food service counters, steam tables, dining room tables, and side service stands with hot and cold food.
- Position involves prolonged standing, walking, reaching, stooping, pushing, pulling and bending. Frequent light to moderate lifting of objects weighing up to 20 pounds occurs routinely, sometimes up to 50 pounds. Uses assistance from other coworkers for moving objects weighing more than 20 pounds.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS and ABILITIES (KSAs) for this position are as follows:

1. Incumbent must possess a minimum of 6 months of customer service experience working in a food service role. Experience as a barista preferred.
2. Experience functioning in a fast-paced restaurant, catering, or cafe environment, managing tasks efficiently under short time constraints and maintaining sanitation standards.
3. Experience using a POS (Point of Sale) system or Cash register in a food service role. Experience as a server or barista preferred.
4. Experience using and cleaning equipment such as espresso machines, grinders, brewers.

QUALIFICATIONS & CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

Applicants who meet the qualification requirements will be further evaluated to determine the extent to which their education, related experience, training, awards, and supervisory appraisal demonstrate they possess the desired knowledge, skills, and abilities (KSAs).

- Must obtain and maintain a security clearance – requires 18 years of age
- Males born after December 31, 1959 must be registered for Selective Service
- Verification of employment eligibility in the United States is required
- Probationary period: Flexible employees are employed based on the needs of the business
- Must be able to understand and communicate in English
- Must complete an Occupational Health screening for this position

Acceptance or declination of a regular position ends ability to claim preference for spouse or Involuntarily Separated (IVS) applicants. To claim a preference, you must attach the following documents with your employment application and request form:

- **ICTAP (Interagency Career Transition Assistance Plan):** Most recent SF50 (or equivalent) and RIF (Reduction in Force) notice.
- **Military Spouse:** most current military member's PCS orders, submit spousal request form – (*Per the CNIC 5300.206b, spouses' preferential consideration for NAF positions at the NF-3 and below*)
- **Veteran:** Page four (4) of the DD-214

Note: Failure to provide the required information may result in loss of consideration for the position and elimination from the selection process. Please be advised that applications received after Noon on the closing date listed above will not be considered. Some positions have special requirements. In these cases, selection is tentative pending satisfactory completion of said requirements. Applicants may be required to provide proof of education, complete a pre-hire health screening, etc. All selections are contingent on obtaining satisfactory employment reference checks.

We are an E-Verify participant. Please be informed that applicants will be required to submit a federal government background check. As a condition of employment, the selectee will be required to participate in direct deposit as specified in the negotiated agreement.
